DISCHARGE INSTRUCTIONS: Minor Procedures

Please note:

Within 24 Hours of your Operation you must not:

- Drive a car or take public transport unaccompanied.
- Operate Machinery
- Consume alcohol
- Sign any legal documents or make any responsible decisions.

Analgesia:

- Take Paracetamol/Panadeine or prescribed medication regularly or as required for comfort.
- Do not drive or operate machinery if taking prescribed medication.

Care of the Wound:

- Remove dressings as instructed by your Surgeon or Nursing Staff. If no instruction given, leave in place until your review appointment with the Dr. or Nurse in the Rooms.
- If sutures are present these will be removed at the time of the review appointment.
- Generally you will have waterproof dressings in place which you can shower with but if you have any concerns please do not hesitate to contact the Rooms.

On-Going Care:

- An appointment will be made for you prior to your discharge from hospital.
- If not, please call our rooms on **9760 2777** to arrange your post operative appointment.
- Notify the Rooms
 - if you experience any problems with your wound including abnormal redness, pain or discharge.
 - You develop a fever or get hot/cold flushes
 - Your pain is not being relieved by the analgesia you are using.

Out of Hours: Ph: 9760 2777

- A recorded message will give you details of how to contact the Surgeon on call, who will assist you with your concerns.
- If you are unable to contact the Surgeon on call, go to the Emergency Dept of either Knox Private Hospital or the Valley Private Hospital. There will be an out-of-pocket cost for this visit.
